

**SCHOLARSHIP BULLETIN

NEW FOR APRIL**

COCA-COLA/MTS HIGH SCHOOL ESSAY CONTEST: Forty (40) San Diego County SENIORS will be awarded a laptop computer based on a written 5-minute speech to fellow high school students outlining how they can reduce their carbon footprint by taking public transportation. The speech must be at least 750 words and typed in 12-point font.

DEADLINE: April 17, 2009

JESSIE KLICKA FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP: Scholarships between \$1,000 and \$2,000 (renewable for four years) will be awarded to SENIORS in San Diego County who plan to attend a 4-year college or university. Applicants will be judged on academics, extracurricular activities and financial need. Please return your application materials to Mrs. Aragon.

DEADLINE: March 3, 2009

JUNIOR SEAU FOUNDATION SCHOLARS OF EXCELLENCE: Applicants for the Scholars of Excellence program must be graduating SENIORS from San Diego County who will attend a four-year college or university in the fall of 2009. There will be awards ranging from \$2,500 to \$10,000.

DEADLINE: April 20, 2009

CUYAMACA COLLEGE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP: Awards of \$750 each will be awarded to two SENIORS who will attend Cuyamaca College in the 2009-2010 academic year. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0, submit a personal statement and one letter of recommendation.

DEADLINE: March 13, 2009 (please return to Mrs. Aragon for delivery)

LAMDA THETA ALPHA PHENOMENAL WOMAN SCHOLARSHIP: Two SENIOR WOMEN will be awarded \$250 each based on a two-page personal statement and a letter of recommendation. Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and plan to attend an accredited University in Fall 2009.

DEADLINE: April 28, 2009

LADY OF LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIPS: The San Diego Chapter of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority will award scholarships to SENIOR WOMEN within San Diego County based on the students' ability to demonstrate leadership within the community.

DEADLINE: April 30, 2009

GROSSMONT SCHOOLS FCU SCHOLARSHIPS: Three \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to SENIORS as follows: Plan A Scholarship applicants must have a parent, grandparent and/or immediate family member who is a Grossmont Schools Federal Credit Union member; Plan B Scholarship applicants must graduate from the Grossmont Union High School District and attend either Grossmont or Cuyamaca College in fall of 2009. **DEADLINE:** May 1, 2009

NORDSTROM SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM: Five scholarships in the amount of \$10,000 (\$2,500 per year for four years) will be awarded to current JUNIORS in San Diego County with an unweighted GPA between 2.7 and 4.0 who have made a substantial contribution to the community, are involved in school activities and demonstrate financial need for a scholarship.

DEADLINE: June 1, 2009

ELK'S TEENAGER OF THE MONTH: The Elk's Lodge 1812 will award \$350 each month to one male and one female SENIOR from throughout the Grossmont High School District. Nominees will be judged on character, leadership, service, citizenship and scholastic achievement. Please submit an application, letter of recommendation and wallet-sized photo to Mrs. Aragon. The sooner you submit your application, the more months you will be eligible for selection.
